In the Music Makers program, each student receives a private lesson and ensemble class each week, and a quality musical instrument to use while enrolled.

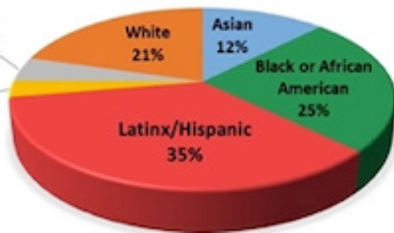
There is a recommended subsidized fee and families are asked to pay what they can. 44% of Music Makers students were eligible for free-and-reduced lunch in FY 2022-23.

By The Numbers:

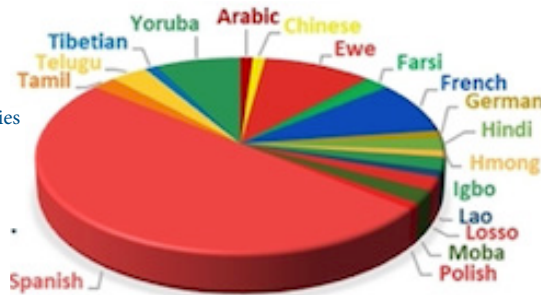
- 116 Music Makers students attended a private lesson each week all year.
- 22 students participated in more than one ensemble.
- 6 students participate in the MM Teen Teachers Program and created the Music Makers Student Council.
- Students performed in 4 Music Makers Concerts and Recitals as well as numerous community celebrations.

Private Lessons Taught Each Week:

Violin: 54 lessons, Piano: 33 Lessons, Guitar: 18 Lessons, Viola: 6 Lessons, Cello: 2 Lessons, Bass: 1 Lesson

Guitar; Violin & Viola; Cello & Bass; Percussion; and Music Theory
