




August 2024 WYSO Music Makers Updates


In the Music Makers program, each student receives a private lesson and ensemble class each week, and a quality musical instrument to use while enrolled.

There is a recommended subsidized fee and families are asked to pay what they can. 54% of Music Makers students were eligible for free-and-reduced lunch in FY 2023-24.

77% of Music Makers Families speak a language other than English at home.



By The Numbers:

- 159 total students enrolled in the WYSO Music Makers Program.
- 99 private lessons (averaged over 3 sessions) taught each week.
- 8 Music Makers members served as Teen Teachers.
- 5 Music Makers members served on the Music Makers Student Council
- Students performed in 2 Music Makers concerts and 4 Music Makers recitals, and in 6 special performances throughout the season, including Symphony Soup alongside the MSO.

Private Lessons Taught Each Week:

Violin: 40 lessons; Piano: 33 lessons; Guitar: 20 lessons; Viola: 5 lessons; Cello: 3 lessons; Percussion: 2 lessons;

Oboe: 1 lesson

Weekly Group Class Instruction:

(Offered at multiple levels of instruction) Guitar; Violin & Viola; Cello & Bass; Percussion; General Music;
